We have been given some heavily discounted prices under the **Learn to Ski programme** . Check out the information and prices below.

## Location : Turoa and Whakapapa

RAL aims to provide an unforgettable on-snow experience while keeping it affordable for school groups. In order to maintain a flat rate for all students, we have introduced a one fixed package with optional add-ons regardless of pre-owned lift passes or equipment. FOC packages (this excludes optional add-ons) will be made available to supervising adults who are in ratio of the students that are purchasing packages. For every 6 student packages purchased, 1 adult package will be FOC for the accompanying adults. Additional adult packages can be purchased at the same price of student packages. 
