SNOW TRIP

Tuesday 30 July to Wednesday 31 July

We are offering a snow trip for 20 of our Year 4-8 students who are keen to learn how to ski. We will be staying overnight at the Memorial hut on Ruapehu on the Whakapapa side of the mountain.

We have been given some heavily discounted prices under the **Learn to Ski programme**. Check out the information and prices below.

Location : Turoa and Whakapapa

RAL aims to provide an unforgettable on-snow experience while keeping it affordable for school groups. In order to maintain a flat rate for all students, we have introduced a one fixed package with optional add-ons regardless of pre-owned lift passes or equipment. FOC packages (this excludes optional add-ons) will be made available to supervising adults who are in ratio of the students that are purchasing packages. For every 6 student packages purchased, 1 adult package will be FOC for the accompanying adults. Additional adult packages can be purchased at the same price of student packages.
