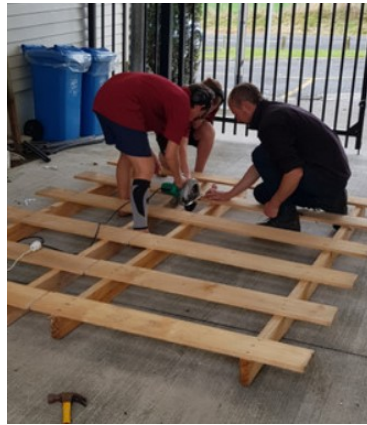
Our enviro-rangers planting some small native seedlings down in our new native bush area. Great work team this is just a start. 😊

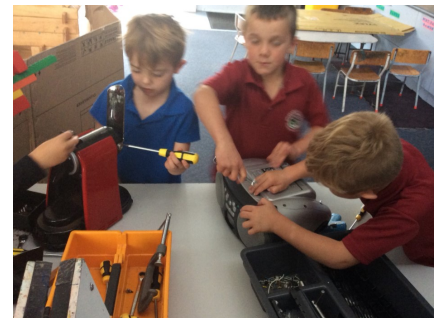
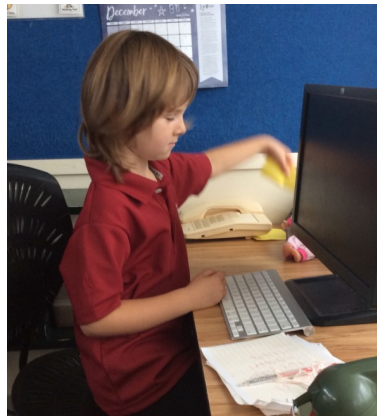

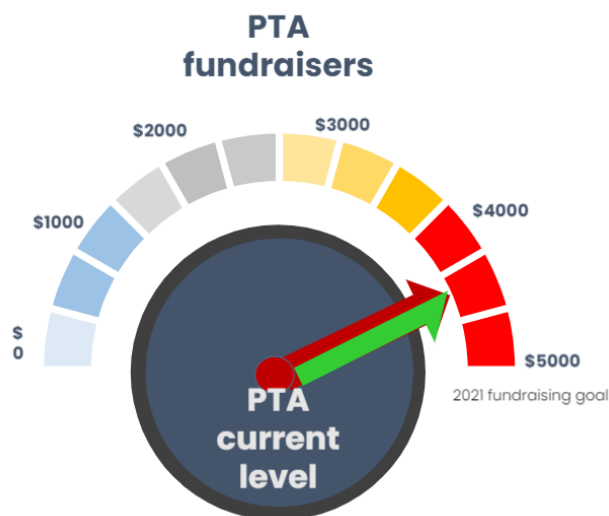
