

## Re: Welcome to the Whakamaru School

Dear Parents/Caregivers

We welcome you and your whanau to our Whakamaru School community. We look forward to getting to know you, your child and whanau.

In the enrolment pack, you will be given the *Schools Prospectus* that is full of information about the school, as well as some forms that we require every parent/caregiver of child/ren in the school to fill out and sign. Please ensure you fill the below forms out with your child and return them as soon as possible.

**Enrolment (blue) form -** This has your family's address, birth certificate etc. New entrant please provide your child's birth certificate or passport and immunisation certificate. Please ensure you add any medical information no matter how small it maybe, also please add any food allergies or restrictions your child has.

**Field Trips, change of address, permission and newsletter form (yearly)** - To be completed by every family and signed by parent / caregiver. The signed form gives the student permission to go on school field trips, address changes, opting in to Bible in School and how you would like to receive our school newsletter.

**Student Computer/Tablet and Internet Use Agreement (yearly)**- students understand their responsibilities when using ICT at school. This form must be read and signed by every student.

**Bus Code of Conduct (yearly)** - Every child at Whakamaru School during the school year will possibly travel on a bus, either daily to and from school or to an event or show for example: technology (year 7-8s), Pinelands events etc. This form will ensure that your child understands the rules for travelling on the bus.

**Waikato District Health board permission form -** This gives permission for the public health nurse to share immunisation status with us.

**Community oral health service form -** this form gives information to the Lakes District Health board and ensures your child receives professional dental care and advice by the dental therapist.
