#### ATTENDANCE

As you may be aware, The Ministry of Education has increased their attention towards students' low attendance rates across the country. All schools are now required to closely monitor students attendance and formally contact parents if their children fall into any of the following categories:

- Chronic attendance less than 70% attendance
- Moderate attendance 70 to 80% attendance.
- Irregular attendance between 80 and 90% attendance.

The Ministry of Education goal is for all students to be attending school regularly, which equates to more than 90% of the time. See examples of the effects of absences has on your child's development and learning.
